WHO: Founded in early 2012, "Friends" are all volunteers who support the mission of Circle V Ranch

Camp—to provide a traditional, residential summer camp experience in a safe, nurturing environment

for kids ages 7-13. There are no dues or fees to become a "Friend" of Circle V—

just a commitment to help!

WHY: Most children who attend (or want to attend) Circle V Ranch Camp need financial assistance to

do so. Of the 500 kids who attended Camp in Summer 2019, 94% received scholarships

known as "camperships" to help their family pay the fees.

WHEN: Year-round opportunities to volunteer & contribute work/wealth/wisdom are available at Circle V.

NEEDS: Monetary donations for camperships (\$550 per child) are always needed and welcomed.

For summer 2021, here are some of the actual items needed:

Archery equipment: (New bows, arrows tabs and armguards) - \$250

Beach Towels: (100 needed for kids who don't bring their own) - \$500

Board Games: (new or gently used)(games such as Mancala and uno cards are popular) - \$250

Brushes and Hair Ties - \$200

• First Aid Supplies (Face masks, insect repellant, sun block, Hand Sanitizer) - \$1,000

Flashlights and Batteries: (100 needed for kids who don't bring them) - \$500

Sports Equipment (frisbee golf, carpetball, Ping Pong Table- \$500

Gymnastics mats - \$1,000

Outdoor portable shade kits- \$7,000

Portable Climbing Wall- \$25,000

Solar Panels Kitchen/ Pool Shower House- \$25,000

WHERE: In Santa Barbara County's beautiful Santa Ynez Valley across from Cachuma Lake

(Address: 2550 Highway 154, Santa Barbara, CA 93105)

WHAT: A traditional summer camp with activities including hiking, swimming, nature, beach, archery,

arts &crafts, painting, drum circle, reading program, photography, baseball, basketball, ping-pong, foosball, soccer, miniature golf, campfires, skits & songs. Campers stay in air-conditioned cabins

and enjoy 3 nutritious daily meals—supervised by caring, trained counselors and staff.

HISTORY: Circle V Ranch Camp was founded by the Society of St. Vincent de Paul Council of Los Angeles

in 1945, and has been located on 30 acres in the Los Padres National Forest in Santa Barbara County's Santa Ynez Valley since 1990. During autumn, winter and spring, the Camp is available

for rental to other non-profit groups and organizations for meetings and retreats.
