Before Camp



CIRCLE V'S ROLE:

- Enhanced staff training with special emphasis on COVID-19 information & protocols
- Health screening of all campers & staff upon arrival on site
- intensified cleaning
- All Staff will be vaccinated prior to arrival at camp



PARENTS ROLE:

- 7-10 days prior to your camp session
- Reduce exposure to Others
- Reinforce proper personal hygiene techniques at home
- Monitor for symptoms
- Please note due to New State and County regulations all campers not vaccinated will be required to get a COVID -19 PCR test 72 hours prior to their arrival at camp. Antigen tests will be acceptable but must be conducted within 8 hours of arrival. Results of the test must be available prior to entry into the camp.

Do not send campers to camp if your child has any cold/flu symptoms or if your child has been exposed to someone with COVID-19.

During Camp



CAMPER INTERACTION:

- Modified opening & closing day procedures to limit visitors on site
- Proper handwashing & personal hygiene techniques emphasized
- Reduced number of outfits & campers in cabins
- Campers will travel & interact with smaller cohorts
- Modifying or eliminating Large group programming
- Modified dining experience to eliminate or reduce exposure to others



MEDICAL CARE:

- Daily temperature checks for campers and staff
- Designated isolation Locations for anyone displaying symptoms
- Parent's should be available to pick their camper up within 8 hours should illness warrant a camper be sent home.



FACILITIES:

- Cabins and bathrooms cleaned and sanitized daily
- Surfaces in dining hall, trading post & recreation equipment sanitized multiple times per day
- More handwashing stations



RESPONSE IN CASE OF ILLNESS:

- Updated Health Center Procedures with COVID-19 specific information
- Quarantine of campers and staff with COVID-19 like symptoms. Campers will be isolated, assessed, and if appropriate sent home

After Camp



INCREASED CLEANING :

More time to clean and sanitize our facilities by shortening camp sessions.



LIMITED INTERACTION :

Campers should limit interaction for 7-10 days after camp with those who are at higher risk of serious illness with COVID-19.
